

# RUDY SHOOT RULES

The teams for this tournament will be seeded in the order of their league finish. For the purpose of seeding, ties will be broken based on head-to-head meetings between the teams in-question. Normal tie rules apply for the breaking of ties in the actual league. **Each league will shoot on the first available Wednesday following the last regularly scheduled match of the season.** The locations will be published in the season's final standings. In addition, each team captain will be contacted personally by a board member to confirm location.

Play will begin at 7:45pm with 1<sup>st</sup> place vs. 4<sup>th</sup> place and 2<sup>nd</sup> place vs. 3<sup>rd</sup> place. The format is as follows:

**Team 1001** – *double on, double off*  
**Doubles 501** – *single on, double off*  
**Doubles 501** – *single on, double off*  
**Team Tactics** – *cricket (call shot)*  
**Doubles 501** – *single on, double off*  
**Doubles 501** – *single on, double off*  
**Team 1001** – *double on, double off*

All normal PDO Rules of Play apply for the Rudy Shoot with the addition of some special rules. The special rules for this tournament are as follows:

- The home team shall be the higher seeded team in each pair
- No player may play in two consecutive doubles games
- No two players may team-up twice in the same match
- Four players minimum to play. Team games may be played by four players without skipping a turn.

The finals are to begin fifteen minutes after the last semi-final match is completed. The team trophy, with the team name engraved, will be awarded at the Awards Ceremony. Each site will have a league officer or representative there to answer any questions that may arise.
